

**SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR  
STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMS 2022-2023  
BCI – UQAM**

Specific admission criteria for some programs are listed in this document. The programs are indexed first by level of study (undergraduate and postgraduate) and then by faculty. Exchange students can find all necessary and pertinent information to verify their admissibility at UQAM according to their desired program.

**PROGRAM SELECTION**

- ✓ The candidate must identify **only one program of studies** in the application form.
- ✓ The chosen program must be part the **study programs open to exchange students**, otherwise the application will not be considered. This list of programs can be found on the BCI website in the UQAM section.
- ✓ The candidate must ensure to have the **required minimum average** in order to access the desired program. Students seeking to apply for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of an undergraduate program must also include their academic results of the Fall semester of their 1<sup>st</sup> university academic year when filing their application. The minimal grade published is the grade of the studies done in France. An **equivalency chart** is included for other countries at the end of this document.
- ✓ In order to be admitted, candidates must be enrolled at their home institution in a discipline related to the identified program at UQAM.
- ✓ Certain programs have limited enrolment for exchange students. This information can be found in this document.
- ✓ Certain study programs are unable to accept students for the full academic year or, on the contrary, only for the full academic year. In some programs, students could be admitted either for the Fall semester only or the Winter semester. Be sure to consider this when choosing a program of studies at UQAM and filling out the BCI form.

**ADMISSION CRITERIA - GRADUATE STUDIES**

- ✓ Certain Master's programs (or DESS) require 16 years of schooling (equivalent of Master 1) before participating in an exchange program with UQAM. The list of these programs can be found at the end of this document.
- ✓ Candidates completing their 4<sup>th</sup> year in a field of study leading to an **engineer degree** in France are not eligible for the postgraduate programs (Master's or DESS) since they have not received their engineer degree at the time of their arrival at UQAM, even if they have completed 16 years of schooling (undergraduate +4). However, these candidates have access to undergraduate studies.

- ✓ Courses are offered in French at UQAM. The minimum accepted level of French is B2 (Intermediate/Advanced) according to the CEFRL Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL).

## **COURSE SELECTION**

- ✓ The candidate must use the course selection form, which can be found on the BCI website.
- ✓ The candidate must provide a course selection from **one study program and one cycle of studies only** (undergraduate or postgraduate programs).

## SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

### Undergraduate Programs

---

#### Faculty of Arts

##### ***Baccalauréat en art dramatique (Bachelor of Dramatic Art) (Scenography 7603) (Theater Studies 6507)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ Candidates must:
  - ✓ Be registered in a similar program at their home institution;
  - ✓ Present a letter showing their interest in studying at *École supérieure de théâtre*.
- ▶ Some courses are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ **For Scenography (7603) only** : Present a portfolio including the student's main achievements, additional training (if applicable) and relevant professional experiences related to the academic training.

##### ***Baccalauréat en arts visuels et médiatiques (Bachelor of Visual and Media Arts) (7324)***

- ▶ For their application, candidates must:
  - ✓ Provide short motivation letter (no more than 500 words)
  - ✓ Provide a visual portfolio of recent work including a maximum of 20 images and an electronic description of the work (title, date, medium, format [height X width X depth]);
    - Provide images in *jpg* formats, dimensions: 1280 x 1024, and at a resolution of 72 dpi;
    - Provide animation, video and installation projects in QuickTime or AVI formats. Make sure they last no longer than 3 minutes.

##### ***Baccalauréat en danse, concentration pratiques artistiques (Bachelor of Dance, specialization in art-based practices) (6511):***

- ▶ Limited enrolment (6 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must:
  - ✓ Be registered in a similar program and/or possess relevant dance experience;
  - ✓ Present a video recording of a solo performance (3 minutes) and excerpts from a technique class (5 minutes) on a DVD that is either MAC- or PC-compatible;
  - ✓ Present a file including the student's main achievements, additional training (if applicable) and relevant professional experiences related to the academic training.
  - ✓ Provide a short motivation letter with their application
- ▶ Some workshops are not open to exchange students.

##### ***Baccalauréat en design de l'environnement (Bachelor of Environmental Design) (7322)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).
- ▶ Student's application must include:
  - ✓ A visual portfolio of their personal work including drawings, photos, or layouts of urban design, architecture, industrial design, etc.; USB flash drives and DVDs will not be accepted.

***Baccalauréat en design graphique (Bachelor of Graphic Design) (7779)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).
- ▶ Selection of the students will be based on the quality of the portfolio and academic results.
- ▶ Student applications must include:
  - ✓ A visual portfolio of their personal work including a maximum of 20 elements of personal or academic creations or research;

***Baccalauréat en études littéraires (Bachelor of Literature) (6862)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

***Baccalauréat en histoire de l'art (Bachelor of Art History) (Regular 7240) et (Museology and art diffusion 7250)***

- ▶ To take courses with codes starting by HAR44XX, HAR45XX, HAR46XX and HAR47XX, candidates must have obtained a certain number of university credits in art history and prerequisites if applicable.

***Baccalauréat en musique, concentration pratique artistique (Bachelor of Music, Artistic Practice 7099) and (Bachelor of Music, teaching 7602)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must:
  - ✓ Be enrolled in a similar program at their home institution;
  - ✓ Provide a folder outlining key achievements, additional training, and any professional activities related to training;
- ▶ Some practical courses are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Majeure en musique (Major in Music) (6377)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must:
  - ✓ Be enrolled in a similar program at their home institution;
  - ✓ Provide a folder outlining key achievements, additional training, and any professional activities related to training.
  - ✓ Attach a short motivation letter to their application
- ▶ Some practical courses are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Certificat en création littéraire (Certificate in literary creation) (4289)***

- ▶ Moyenne cumulative minimale exigée pour l'ensemble du cursus universitaire : 12/20.

***Certificat en scénarisation cinématographique (Certificate in Cinematographic Scriptwriting) (4327)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required : 3,20 (12/20).

***Baccalauréat en action culturelle (Bachelor of Cultural Action) (6525)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Workshops are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Baccalauréat en communication (Bachelor of Communications) (Digital Media 6637) and (Human and organizational communication 6638)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Workshops are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Baccalauréat en communication, journalisme (Bachelor of Communications, Journalism 7433)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment (5 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Workshops are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Baccalauréat en communication marketing (Bachelor of Communications marketing) (7210)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).
- ▶ Workshops are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Baccalauréat en communication, relations publiques (Bachelor of Communications, Public relations) (7434)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).
- ▶ Workshops are not open to exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter. No admission for the full academic year.

***Majeure en communication (Major in Communication) (6960)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required : 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Workshops are not open for exchange students.
- ▶ Admission for one semester only – fall or winter – No admission for the full academic year.

***Majeure en anglais et culture anglophone (Major in English and anglophone culture) (6007)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,90/4,3 (11,25/20).
- ▶ Only candidates with a level of English corresponding to level 3000 (Intermediate 2, level B2 according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages - CECRL) or higher are eligible.
- ▶ All candidates must take a mandatory Placement Test from the *École de langues de UQAM* prior to register to the courses. Candidates must consent to respect the results of the test and to take the courses accordingly.

***Majeure en langue et cultures modernes (6021 et 6022) (Major in Modern Language and Cultures 6021 and 6022)***

- ▶ For French and any other desired languages of study, please attach a certificate according to the CECRL.

French as a second language :

- The student must make an appointment with the Centre d'évaluation de compétences linguistiques to take the French placement test by distance learning: [cecl.uqam.ca/](http://cecl.uqam.ca/)
- Only candidates who have obtained a result corresponding to the intermediate level (level B1 according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages - CECRL) or higher will be admitted to the program.

English :

- Applicants must include a document attesting to their level of English, such as a letter from an English teacher or the result of the TOEFL test.
- Upon arrival in Quebec, applicants must take the UQAM Language School placement test and agree to abide by the results of this evaluation. For details and deadlines: [cecl.uqam.ca](http://cecl.uqam.ca)
- Only candidates with a level of English corresponding to level 2000 (Intermediate 1, level B1 according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages - CECRL) or higher are eligible.

German :

- Applicants must attach their online placement test results to their application: [languages.uqam.ca/german](http://languages.uqam.ca/german)

Arabic, Spanish, Japanese :

- Students who are beginners must indicate this in their application.
- Students who already have a basic knowledge of the language must attach to their application a document attesting to their level of proficiency in the language, such as a letter from a teacher or the result of an internationally recognized standardized test.
- Upon arrival in Quebec, candidates must take the UQAM Language School placement test and agree to abide by the results of this evaluation. For details and deadlines: [cecl.uqam.ca](http://cecl.uqam.ca).

Chinese :

- Students who are beginners must indicate this in their application.
- Students who already have a basic knowledge of Chinese must attach to their application a document attesting to their level in the language, such as a letter from a teacher or the result of an internationally recognized standardized test.
- Upon arrival in Quebec, students who already have a basic knowledge of the language must meet with the Chinese language teacher to confirm their level.

N. B. Since, in most languages, the student's level can only be confirmed after arrival in Quebec, it is likely that adjustments will have to be made to the course selection. The exact number of courses that a student will be able to take in each of the three components of the program (language A, language B and intercultural) depends on the student's placement in each language.

***Certificat en français et anglais : l'expérience montréalaise (Certificate in French and English : Montréal experience) (4569)***

- The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,90/4,3 (11,25/20).
- All candidates must take a mandatory in French and in English Placement Test from the *École de langues de UQAM* prior to register to the courses. Candidates must consent to respect the results of the test and to take the courses accordingly.
- Only candidates with a level of French and English corresponding to level 2000 (Intermediate 1, level B1 according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages - CECRL) or higher are eligible.

***Certificat en anglais (Certificate in English) (4729)***

- The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,90/4,3 (11,25/20).
- Only candidates with a level of English corresponding to level 2000 (Intermediate 1, level B1 according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages - CECRL) or higher are eligible.
- All candidates must take a mandatory Placement Test from the *École de langues de UQAM* prior to register to the courses. Candidates must consent to respect the results of the test and to take the courses accordingly.
- Information on the test and the associated fees is available on the Centre d'évaluation de compétences linguistiques website: [cecl.uqam.ca](http://cecl.uqam.ca).

***Certificat en langues et culture d'Asie (Certificate in Asian Languages and Culture) (4621)***

- In order to study on a full-time basis, the student will need to register to both Chinese and Japanese courses.
- All candidates who already have a basic knowledge of either language must first have their language skills evaluated by the UQAM Language School before being admitted. Information is available on the Language School's website: [langues.uqam.ca/tests-de-classement/](http://langues.uqam.ca/tests-de-classement/).

***Certificat de perfectionnement en français langue seconde (Certificate in Improvement of French as a Second Language) (4650)***

- Candidates must take the UQAM Language School placement test and agree to abide by the results of this evaluation. Information on the test and the associated fees is available on the Centre d'évaluation de compétences linguistiques website: [cecl.uqam.ca](http://cecl.uqam.ca).

- ▶ Only candidates with intermediate level results or higher (level A2 according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages – CECRL) will be admitted.

- ▶ Limited enrolment (5 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

### **Baccalauréat en enseignement de l'anglais langue seconde (Bachelor of Teaching English as a Second Language) (7176)**

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

### **Baccalauréat en enseignement du français langue seconde (Bachelor of Teaching French as a Second Language) (7177)**

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

### **Baccalauréat en enseignement en adaptation scolaire et sociale (Bachelor of Social and Educational Adaptation) (intervention in pre-school and primary education) 7088), (intervention au secondaire 7489)**

- ▶ Limited enrolment (5 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Students will be admitted for the fall semester or for the full academic year. No admission for the winter semester only.

### **Baccalauréat en administration (Bachelor in Administration) (Finance 7111), (Marketing 7112), (Gestion des ressources humaines 7113), (Gestion des opérations 6538), (Technologies d'affaires 7320), (Management 7668), (Gestion internationale 7669 ):**

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).

### **Baccalauréat en économie (Bachelor in Economics) (Économie appliquée 6571), (Économie et finance 6572), (Économie et gestion 6573), (Économie internationale 6574), (Économie et politiques publiques 6575)**

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).
- ▶ Candidates must be enrolled in an Economics program at their home institution.

### **Baccalauréat en gestion du tourisme et de l'hôtellerie (Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management) (Gestion des organisations et des destinations touristiques 7307), (Gestion hôtelière et de restauration 7317)**

- ▶ Limited enrolment (5 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).
- ▶ The following courses are not open to exchange students: the terminal activity and the EUT4515 course.
- ▶ Candidates are only admitted in the fall semester (no winter or full-year admissions).



***Baccalauréat en gestion et design de la mode (Bachelor's in Management and Fashion Design) (Design et stylisme de mode 6655), (Commercialisation de la mode 6653) (Culture et valorisation de la mode 6536)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must be registered in a similar program at their home institution.

***Baccalauréat en gestion publique (Bachelor of Public Management) (7215)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

***Baccalauréat en sciences comptables (Bachelor in Accounting Sciences) (7330)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must be registered in an accounting sciences program (or the equivalent) at their home institution leading to the accounting profession.

***Baccalauréat en urbanisme (Bachelor of Urban Planning) (formation internationale 8017), (formation régulière 8013)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ The following courses are not open to exchange students:  
EUT1012, EUT1014, EUT1015, EUT1017, EUT5013, EUT5014, EUT5015.

## **Faculty of Political Science and Law**

***Baccalauréat en communication, politique et société (Bachelor of Communications, Politics and Society) (7641)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must be registered in a Political Science program at their home institution.
- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ Some courses with codes starting by EDM are not open to exchange students.

***Baccalauréat en relations internationales et droit international (Bachelor of International Relations and International Law) (7060)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,30 (12,50/20 for the French grading system)
- ▶ Candidates must be registered in a political science or law program at their home institution.

***Baccalauréat en science politique (Bachelor of Political Science) (7760)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,80 (11/20 for the French grading system).
- ▶ Candidates whose average barely satisfies the overall cumulative GPA required could be refused after a study of their file and the seriousness of their application procedure.

## **Faculty of Sciences**

***Baccalauréat en actuariat (Bachelor of Actuarial Sciences) (7363)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,0/4,3 (10/20).
- ▶ Candidates must be registered in a similar program at their home institution (mathematics, actuarial sciences or statistics).

***Baccalauréat en biochimie (Bachelor of Biochemistry) (6542)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,0/4,3 (10/20).

***Baccalauréat en chimie (Bachelor of Chemistry) (6532)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,0/4,3 (10/20).

***Baccalauréat en biologie en apprentissage par problèmes (Bachelor of Biology in Problem-based Learning) (6713)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Once the student is admitted, the final course selection will have to be established with the approval of the Director of the program at UQAM.
- ▶ The program is divided into three years and it is recommended to take the courses of a single year or a single term to avoid scheduling conflicts.
- ▶ The BIA1000 course (fall) or the BIA1002 course (winter) must be taken during the exchange. These intensive courses are offered before the official start of the term.
  - **Note that some courses begins on August 1<sup>st</sup>.**

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

***Baccalauréat d'intervention en activité physique (Bachelor of Physical Activity Intervention) (enseignement de l'éducation physique et à la santé 7236) (kinésiologie 7328)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment.
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

***Baccalauréat en mathématiques (Bachelor of Mathematics) (Mathematics 7721)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

***Baccalauréat en sciences de la Terre et de l'atmosphère (Bachelor of Earth and Atmospheric Sciences) (Geology 7442), (Meteorology 7459)***

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

**Baccalauréat en travail social (Bachelor of Social Work) (6998)**

- ▶ Limited enrolment (2 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,40 (13/20).

**Mineure en études classiques (Minor in Classical studies) (8866)**

- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,80 (11/20).

**IMPORTANT** – Candidates applying for a graduate program **must** provide a list of the courses taken during the present academic year and their descriptors.

### Faculty of arts

#### ***Maîtrise en arts visuels et médiatiques, concentration création (Master's in Visual and Media Arts, Creation) (3574)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment (2 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 2,80 (11/20).
- ▶ Candidates must provide :
  - ✓ A personal resume describing applicant's relevant experience in visual arts and artistic achievements;
  - ✓ Research proposal (one paragraph) accompanied by a description of no more than 2 pages;
  - ✓ 20 digital photographs (.JPG ; format 1024 x 768) and/or a video of no more than 5 minutes in QuickTime format(.mov). If the candidates submit a CD-ROM, it must be compatible with MAC or PC.
- ▶ Candidates must have successfully completed 16 years of schooling (Master 1 completed) before the exchange.
- ▶ Students will be admitted for the fall semester only or the full academic year. No admission for the winter semester only.

#### ***Maîtrise en danse (Master's in Dance) (Creation 1801) (Research 1802)***

- ▶ Limited enrolment (2 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
- ▶ Candidates must have relevant experience in dance or movement and have completed a university program in dance or a related discipline from the following list: Theatre, Visual Arts, Music, Media Arts, Art History, Literature, or another discipline approved by the department such as Physical Education, Somatic Practice, Psychology, Communication, Kinanthropology, Psychomotor Education.

#### **DESS en éducation somatique (3273) (DESS in somatic education)**

- ▶ Limited enrolment (2 students).
- ▶ The overall cumulative GPA required: 3,20 (12/20).
